**Protein Production and Purification**

The Hauptman-Woodward Institute seeks a lab technician to join the Institute's efforts in combating COVID-19. The successful candidate will be joining a collaborative project between Dr. Diana Monteiro (Hauptman-Woodward) and Dr. Thomas Grant (University at Buffalo) employing biochemical and structural biology techniques to elucidate protein-ligand interactions of COVID19 relevant proteins.

We are looking for a motivated applicant keen to help progress this timely and very relevant project. The technician will be performing standard biochemical and molecular biology tasks within a protein production and purification pipeline as well as support general lab operation. **The work does not involve contact any infectious samples.**

The position will be based at the Hauptman-Woodward Medical Research Institute in Buffalo, NY ([www.hwi.buffalo.edu](http://www.hwi.buffalo.edu)). Extensive safety measures are in place at the Institute to ensure the safe working of staff. The candidate must hold a college degree in biochemistry or related discipline by the time of appointment. Prior knowledge of basic biochemical and molecular biology techniques is required and basic laboratory experience would be highly advantageous.

**Benefits:** As this position is part-time, free parking is provided but health insurance is not offered. The Institute offers a retirement plan with a 6% employer match after one year of service even for part-time employees.
